Do Not Forfeit Father's Day

Father's Day is a little over a month away and every year I remind church leaders not to forfeit Father's Day. I know not all men are Dads, but a good number are. And all of us have Dads. Father's Day is a great day to reach out to all the men of the church and community. So, I have a statement for you: **Do Not Forfeit Father's Day!** As a Men's Ministry Leader, I believe this day is a great day to target our men intentionally, and we should take advantage of it.

To give you a little history about Father's Day, it began when Sonora Smart Dodd in Spokane,

Washington – who was one of six children raised by a widower – had the idea of having a day to celebrate our Fathers while sitting in church on Mother's Day. She went to local churches, the YMCA, and others to gather support for her idea. As a result, on June 19, 1910, Washington State celebrated the nation's first statewide Father's Day. Though Father's Day has become a commercial entity in today's culture, it has its roots in the church. We can bring the original idea of Father's Day back into the church as we honor our Fathers, reaching out to the men of our church and community. But to do so, we need to start planning now. 
